Course Overview

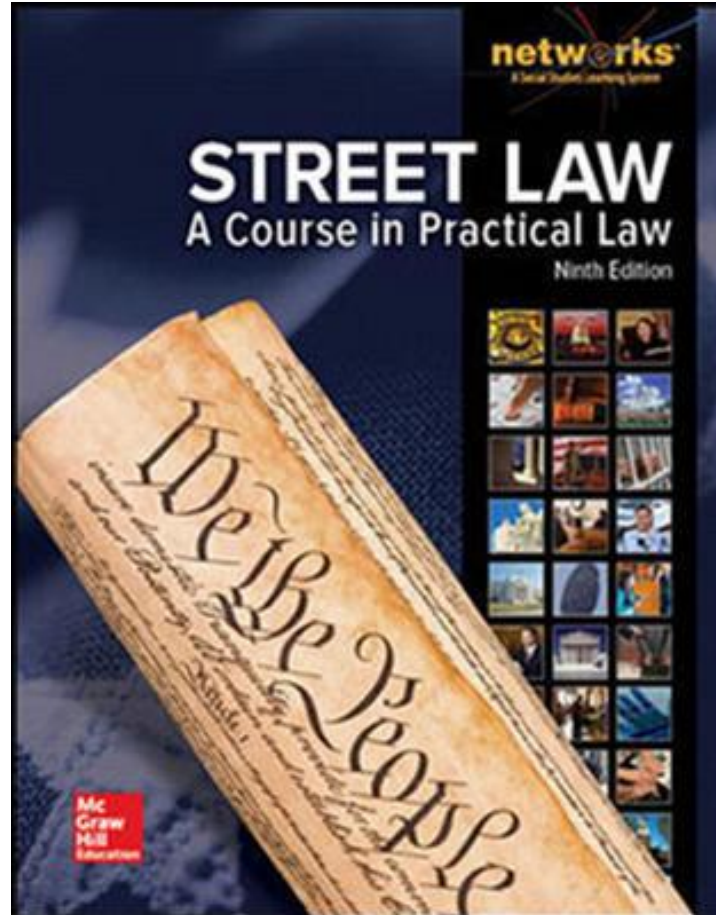
Criminology is a one semester elective course. The purpose of this course is too...

- Examine the role of individuals, institutions, and societal issues involved in criminal justice.

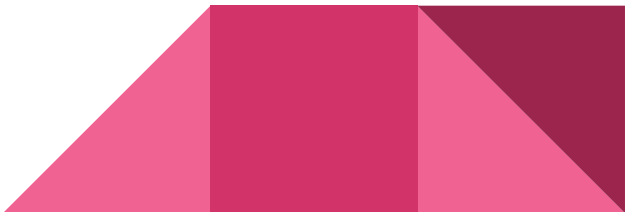
