








Current Project Phase – Agency Review



SED & Owner Items:

- Arch & Engineering addenda submitted to SED for review. Awaiting PM review.
- Ongoing Owner, Tetra Tech & BBL Review Meetings as needed (met on 1/5/2021).

Ongoing Pre-Bid Phase Tasks

- Front Ends:
 - Prime Contracts: General, Plumbing,
 Mechanical, Electrical, Sitework, Roofing
 - Assignment of Work
 - Project Milestone Schedule
 - Temporary Phasing / Conditions
- Constructability Review of SED Documents
- Morse Addition: SED as the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) indicated this approval will take longer. To Avoid Delaying Current Package at SED, addition will be moved to a separate SED submission and Phase of construction.
- Considerations For Bidding / Alternates: Supply Chain Disruptions (Material Shortages
 - + Shipping Delays + Pricing Volatility)
 - = Need for Budget Protection by Alternates
- Phased Approach to Construction










Capital Project Overall Timeline -Updated






EPC Project Update


