

- 1. Students will be graded on quizzes, tests, projects, writing pieces, and assignments that are labeled *"to be graded"*.
- 2. Tests, projects, and extended writing pieces will count twice when calculating an average.
- 3. Quizzes, "to be graded" assignments, and on demand writing will count once when calculating an average.
- 4. Any quizzes, tests, projects, writing pieces, and assignments that are labeled "to be graded" can be handed in 5 school days past their due date with no penalty. After 5 school days the missing assignments will be considered late and receive a 50%.
- 5. A homework grade will also be given, if work is completed completely and effort is noticeable the assignment will be considered 100% and a grade of 100% will be added to the Homework Section of the grade book. *The assignment can be completed 5 days after the due date, if the assignment is past 5 days it will receive a 50%.

Homework Policy

- During solely remote learning(From home or another location) homework will not be given.
- During hybrid learning (two days in school, 3 days home or another location) students may receive work to complete at home. For example: completing math assignments or a writing piece.
- When the hybrid model goes into affect Wednesday can be used as a homework/help day. Various meetings can be scheduled to help with a given topic.
- Some Math homework assignments may be given daily.
- A homework grade will also be given, if work is completed completely and effort
 is noticeable the assignment will be considered 100% and a grade of 100% will
 be added to the Homework Section of the grade book. *Missing assignments can
 be completed 5 days after the due date, if the assignment is past 5 days late it
 will receive a 50%.
